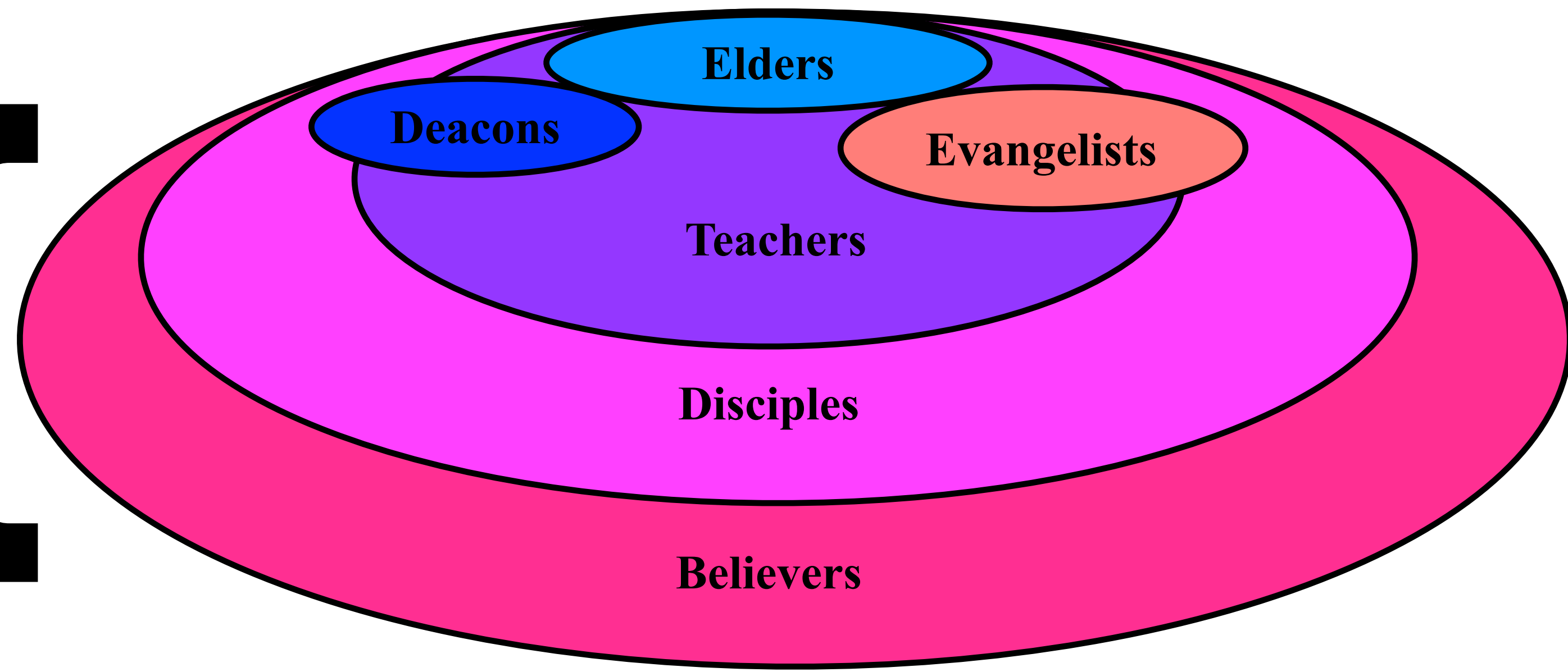
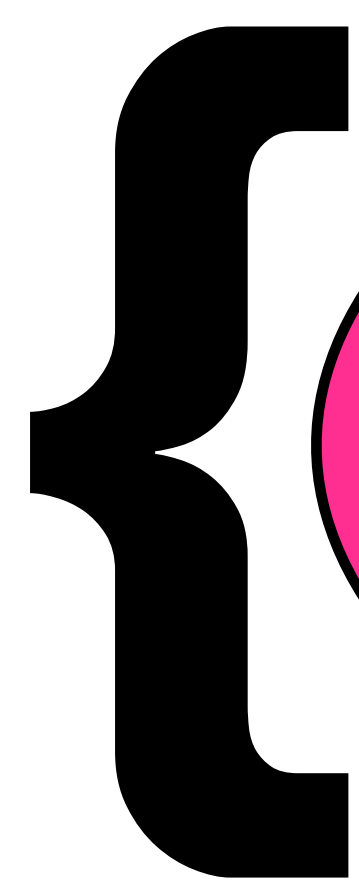


Church Age Chain of Command

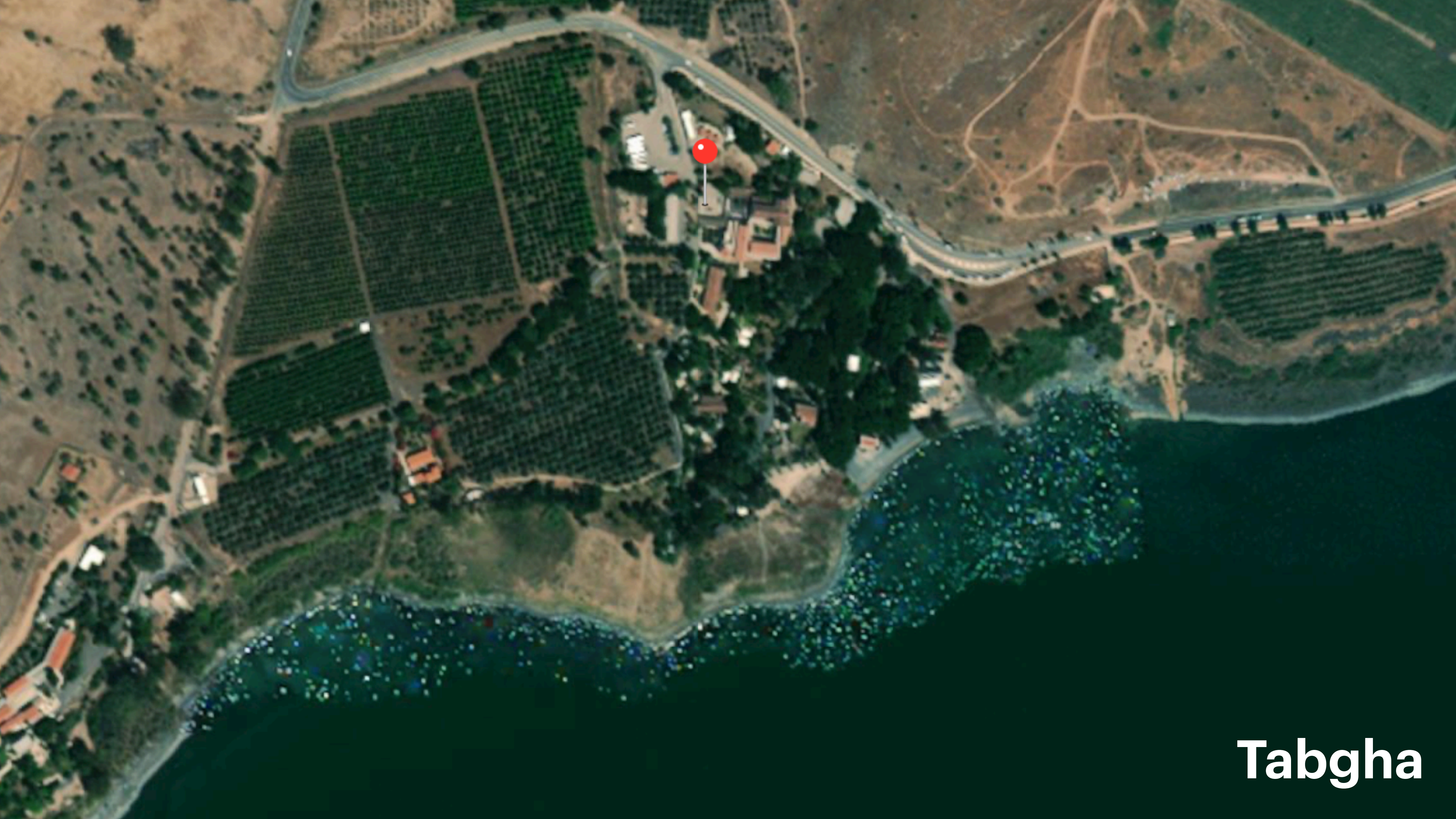




Tabgha - Site of the multiplication of the loave...

Matthew 28:10 10 Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see me.”

“WE’VE SEEN THIS MOVIE BEFORE”

Luke 5:1-11 1 On one occasion, while the crowd was pressing in on [Jesus] to hear the word of God, he was standing by the lake of Gennesaret, 2 and he saw two boats by the lake, but the fishermen had gone out of them and were washing their nets. 3 Getting into one of the boats, which was Simon’s, he asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and taught the people from the boat. 4 And when he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, “Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.” 5 And Simon answered, “Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at your word I will let down the nets.” 6 And when they had done this, they enclosed a large number of fish, and their nets were breaking.

BREAD AND FISH AT THE SEA OF GALILEE

John 6:1 1 After this Jesus went away to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, which is the Sea of Tiberias.

John 6:9–11 9 “There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are they for so many?” 10 Jesus said, “Have the people sit down.” Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, about five thousand in number. 11 Jesus then took the loaves, and when he had given thanks, he distributed them to those who were seated. So also the fish, as much as they wanted.

“But that we may cease from the ancient examples, let us come to those who became athletes near to our own time; let us take the noble examples from our generation. Because of jealousy and envy, the greatest and most righteous pillars of the church were persecuted and they competed until death. Let us set before our eyes the good apostles: Peter, who because of unrighteous jealousy, not once or twice but many times endured hardship and thus having given his testimony he went to the place of glory he deserved”
