

VERSES ON LOVE FOR MAN

Leviticus 19:18 18 You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but you shall *love* your neighbour as yourself. I am Yahweh.

Deuteronomy 10:18-19 18 [Yahweh] executes justice for the fatherless and the widow, and <u>loves</u> the sojourner, giving him food and clothing. 19 <u>Love</u> the sojourner, therefore, for you were sojourners in the land of Egypt.

Psalm 109:4-5 4 In return for my *love* they accuse me, but I give myself to prayer. 5 So they reward me evil for good, and hatred for my *love*.

Proverbs 10:12 12 Hatred stirs up strife, but *love* covers all offences.

Matthew 5:43-48 43 You have heard that it was said, You shall <u>love</u> your neighbour and hate your enemy. 44 But I say to you, <u>Love</u> your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if you <u>love</u> those who <u>love</u> you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? 47 And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? 48 You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

Matthew 22:35-40 35 ...One of [the Pharisees], a lawyer, asked [Jesus] a question to test him. 36 Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Torah? 37 And he said to him, You shall *love* the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. 38 This is the great and first commandment. 39 And a second is like it: You shall *love* your neighbour as yourself. 40 On these two commandments depend all the Torah and the Prophets.

Luke 6:35-36 35 But <u>love</u> your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return, and your reward will be great, and you will be sons¹ of the Most High, for he is kind to the ungrateful and the evil.

John 13:34-35 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you <u>love</u> one another. Just as I have <u>loved</u> you, you also are to <u>love</u> one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have <u>love</u> for one another.²

John 15:12-17 12 This is my commandment, that you <u>love</u> one another as I have <u>loved</u> you. 13 Greater <u>love</u> has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you. ...17 These things I command you, so that you will <u>love</u> one another.

¹ We are sons of God, and we act most like sons of God when we love our enemies.

² The practice of love indicates who is a disciple of Jesus.



John 17:26 26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the *love* with which you have *loved* me may be in them, and I in them.

Romans 5:5 5 ... And hope does not put us to shame, because God's *love* has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

Romans 12:9-10 9 Let *love* be genuine. Abhor what is evil. Hold fast to what is good. 10 *Love* one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honour.

Romans 13:8-10 8 Owe no one anything, except to <u>love</u> each other, for the one who <u>loves</u> another has fulfilled the Torah. 9 For the commandments, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet, and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: You shall <u>love</u> your neighbour as yourself. 10 <u>Love</u> does no wrong to a neighbour. Therefore <u>love</u> is the fulfilling of the Torah.

1 Corinthians 12:31-13:13 31 And I will show you a still more excellent way. 1 If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not <u>love</u>, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not <u>love</u>, I am nothing. 3 If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not <u>love</u>, I gain nothing. 4 <u>Love</u> is patient and kind. <u>Love</u> does not envy or boast. It is not arrogant 5 or rude. It does not insist on its own way. It is not irritable or resentful. 6 It does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. 7 <u>Love</u> bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 <u>Love</u> never ends. ...13 So now faith, hope, and <u>love</u> abide, these three, but the greatest of these is love.

1 Corinthians 16:14 14 Let all that you do be done in *love*.

1 Corinthians 16:24 24 My *love* be with you all in Messiah Jesus. Amen.

2 Corinthians 2:4 4 ... I wrote to you out of much affliction and anguish of heart and with many tears, not to cause you pain but to let you know the abundant *love* that I have for you.

Galatians 5:6 6 ...In Messiah Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through *love*.

Galatians 5:13-14 13 ... You were called to freedom, brothers and sisters. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through <u>love</u> serve one another. 14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one saying: You shall <u>love</u> your neighbour as yourself.

Galatians 5:22-23 22 ... The fruit of the Spirit is *love*, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Ephesians 1:15-16 15 ...Because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your *love* toward all the saints, 16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers....



- **Ephesians 4:15-16** 15 ... Speaking the truth in <u>love</u>, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Messiah, 16 from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in <u>love</u>.
- **Ephesians 5:2** 2 ... Walk in <u>love</u>, as Messiah <u>loved</u> us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
- **Colossians 1:3-4** 3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah, when we pray for you, 4 because we heard of your faith in Messiah Jesus and of the *love* that you have for all the saints....
- **Colossians 3:14** 14 And above all these put on *love*, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
- **Philippians 1:9-10** 9 ...It is my prayer that your <u>love</u> may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, 10 so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Messiah....
- **Philemon 7** 7 For I have derived much joy and comfort from your *love*, my brother, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed through you.
- **1 Thessalonians 1:2-3** 2 We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, 3 remembering before our God and Father your work of faith, labor of *love*, and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Messiah.
- **1 Thessalonians 3:12** 12 ... And may the Lord [Jesus] make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you....
- **1 Thessalonians 4:9-10** 9 Now concerning brotherly <u>love</u> you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to <u>love</u> one another, 10 for that indeed is what you are doing to all the brothers and sisters throughout Macedonia. But we urge you, brothers and sisters, to do this more and more....
- **2 Thessalonians 1:3** 3 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers and sisters, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the *love* of every one of you for one another is increasing.
- **1 Timothy 1:5** 5 The aim of our charge is *love* that issues from a pure heart, a good conscience, and a sincere faith.
- **Hebrews 6:10** 10 For God is not unjust so as to overlook your work and the <u>love</u> that you have shown for his name in serving the saints, as you still do.
- Hebrews 10:24 24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to <u>love</u> and good works....



- **James 2:8** 8 If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, You shall *love* your neighbour as yourself, you are doing well.
- **1 Peter 1:22** 22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, *love* one another earnestly from a pure heart....
- **1 Peter 2:17** 17 Love the fellowship of believers (ἀδελφότης).
- **1 Peter 4:8** 8 Above all, keep loving $(\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta)$ one another earnestly, because love $(\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta)$ covers a multitude of sins.
- **1 Peter 5:14** 14 Greet one another with the kiss of love. Shalom to all of you who are in Messiah.
- **2 Peter 1:5-8** 5 ... Make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, 6 and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, 7 and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with *love*. 8 For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Messiah.
- 1 John 3:10-23 10 By this it is evident who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not <u>love</u> his brother. 11 For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should <u>love</u> one another. ...14 We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we *love* the brothers. Whoever does not *love* abides in death. 15 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. 16 By this we know <u>love</u>, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. 17 But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's *love* abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not <u>love</u> in word or talk but in deed and in truth. 19 By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him. 20 For whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. 21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God. 22 And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. 23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and <u>love</u> one another, just as he has commanded us.
- 1 John 4:7-12 7 Beloved, let us <u>love</u> one another, for <u>love</u> is from God, and whoever <u>loves</u> has been born of God and knows God. 8 Anyone who does not <u>love</u> does not know God, because God is <u>love</u>. 9 In this the <u>love</u> of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. 10 In this is <u>love</u>, not that we have <u>loved</u> God but that he <u>loved</u> us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11 Beloved, if God so <u>loved</u> us, we also ought to <u>love</u> one another. 12 No one has ever seen God. If we <u>love</u> one another, God abides in us and his <u>love</u> is perfected in us.



- **1 John 4:19-21** 19 We <u>love</u> because he first <u>loved</u> us. 20 If anyone says, I <u>love</u> God, and hates his brother, he is a liar. For he who does not <u>love</u> his brother whom he has seen cannot <u>love</u> God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from him: whoever <u>loves</u> God must also <u>love</u> his brother.
- **1 John 5:1-3** 1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Messiah has been born of God, and everyone who *loves* the Father loves whoever has been born of him. 2 By this we know that we *love* the children of God, when we *love* God and obey his commandments. 3 For this is the *love* of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.
- **2 John 1** 1 The elder to the elect lady and her children, whom I <u>love</u> in truth, and not only I, but also all who know the truth....
- **2 John 5-6** 5 And now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we *love* one another. 6 And this is *love*, that we walk according to his commandments. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.
